Average prices were calculated on the basis of prices gathered from retail outlets at Northmead, Shoprite (Kafue Road), City Market, Chawama, Chainda, Kabwata, Matero and schools, clinics/hospitals around Lusaka. The August Basic Needs Basket is approximately U\$\$522 based upon an average middle exchange rate of 3515 Kwacha per U\$\$ at the end of August.
