Average prices were calculated on the basis of prices gathered from retail outlets at Northmead, Shoprite (Kafue Road), and City Market, Chawama, Chainda, Kabwata, Matero and schools, clinics/hospitals around Lusaka. The November Basic Needs Basket is approximately **US\$483 based** upon an average middle exchange rate of 4669Kwacha per US\$ at the end of November.
